You are cordially invited to attend a five-day Getting to Know Connected Mathematics (CMP) Workshop on the beautiful campus of Michigan State University, June 18–22, 2012. This workshop is intended for teachers, coaches, teacher leaders, and administrators new to the curriculum, new to a grade level of the curriculum, or interested in receiving a more in-depth look at the mathematics and pedagogy of CMP as well as implementation strategies. It is also intended for experienced CMP teachers who want to explore the mathematics in a different grade level from that which they teach. This year a common thread throughout the conference will be a discussion of the **Common Core State Standards (CCSS)** curriculum and the **Mathematical Practices (MP)**.

As an attendee you will have an opportunity to be part of a 6th, 7th, or 8th grade group that will

- Receive an in-depth look at CMP2 for your grade level;
- Examine the development of the mathematics in a grade with a focus on how understanding is developed and connected within and across units;
- Experience and discuss a pedagogical model for teaching CMP;
- Alignment of CMP2 with the CCSS;
- How the MP in CMP2 enhance student learning;
- Discuss implementation, management, and grading strategies;
- Learn about special features of CMP2 and support resources;
- Participate in a special CMP-based carnival complete with fabulous prizes; and
- Share ideas with other CMP teachers

### Schedule

The conference will convene at 7:30 A.M. on Monday, June 18th, with check-in and a continental breakfast. Each day will begin at 8:00 A.M. following a continental breakfast and end at 5:00 P.M., except Wednesday, which will end around 5:30 P.M. On Wednesday there will be a carnival with CMP games, prizes, and appetizers from 4–5:30 P.M. Lunch, except for Friday, is on your own. ### Air Travel

The Lansing community is served by a couple of airlines at the Capital Region International Airport. Their web site is [www.flylansing.com](http://www.flylansing.com). You can expect the cost of a taxi from the airport to your hotel to run about \$25. You may also want to inquire as to whether your hotel provides a shuttle.

The Marriott and Kellogg hotels provide free shuttle services to and from the Lansing airport for their guests. Call the hotel upon your arrival for this service—courtesy phones are located in the Baggage Claim area.

It is also possible, and usually cheaper, to fly into Detroit Metropolitan Airport and take a shuttle from the Airport to the Marriott at University Place in downtown East Lansing for \$50 round trip. Flying in and out of Flint or Grand Rapids is also an option, but you'll need to rent a car.
